A short, informal, introductory (pilot) course for anyone wanting to find out more about ‘how their community works’ which will include speakers and a social activity; run by ...

Who’s this course for? We are looking for adults and young people (16+ years) and from different groups, neighbourhoods and/or ethnicity to take part.

The course will build your confidence in:

- sharing your local knowledge with others and learning from them;
- finding out what’s happening across the whole community;
- exploring together a local issue or concern in more detail;
- talking with local decision-makers about that issue.

A 5 session course that is relaxed and will offer:

- flexible support from the trainers;
- the opportunity for a social activity;
- a local certificate and reference.

You do not need strong reading and writing skills to join in.

Support to take part can include:

- childcare
- transport
- help with joining in discussions, e.g. a hearing induction loop, working with a partner.
